



The ACB Grenada Bank / SGU Undergraduate Scholarship Programme

The ACB Grenada Bank / SGU Undergraduate Scholarship Programme was launched in 2023 in keeping with ACB Caribbean Group's Corporate Social Responsibility pillars of youth development and education.

The Programme was designed by ACB Caribbean Group in collaboration with the admissions team at St. George's University, True Blue Campus in Grenada.

The scholarship is a tuition award for the final two years of Undergraduate Studies at St. George's University. The ideal candidate for this award should be a well-rounded Grenadian National, with a solid Academic track record.

Involvement in extra circular activities as well as being an active member of the community or a track record of volunteerism would be in the applicant's favour.

The eligible disciplines / fields of study are as follows:

- Business & Management
- Computer & Technology
- Marine Wildlife Conservation Biology

To qualify, applicants must meet the following Criteria:

- Minimum GPA of 3.0
- Citizen of Grenada
- Must be resident in Grenada for 12 months prior to application deadline date
- Open to students already in the programme or TAMCC Graduates
- Community Service or volunteerism
- Extra-Curricular activities – sport, music, dance, cultural activities
- November 15th application deadline date annually
- Applicants must submit a 300 word essay along with their application, outlining why they are the ideal candidate to receive this Scholarship Award.

Weighting:

66% Academics – GPA of 3.0 or higher, 33% weighting based on at least one of the following:

- Community Service
- Volunteerism
- Extra-Curricular activities – sport, music, cultural activities

Conditions

- Recipients must work in Grenada or the OECS for 2 years after graduation / or be in pursuit of higher education (Master's programme or additional undergraduate programme)
- Annual August Admission (August semester start date)
- Award is for the final 2 years of study in the undergraduate programme
- The Recipient must maintain a GPA of 3.0 or above to qualify for funding for the final year of study
- Must not be the recipient of any other scholarship or bursary for tuition
- Existing awardees must provide transcripts for renewal in second year
- Must be available for public relations activities (interviews, photography, videography)
